What a rollercoaster year 2024 has been at We Care Tucson! It was a year of tremendous growth, transformation, and continued expansion of our youth initiatives. Building on the momentum of 2023, we pushed forward with innovation and community empowerment, setting new benchmarks for excellence.



Our Youth Tech Camp flourished, expanding to three incredible weeks, while our School Day Out programs and TechFest continued to inspire young minds eager to explore the dynamic world of technology. This fall, we introduced an exciting new component—robotics—bringing hands-on STEM experiences to even more students. These programs, rooted in the success of our Youth Tech Camp, are bridging the digital divide for underserved youth and igniting a passion for technology.



Guiding this growth, our Director of Technology and Erecycling, Coleman Hammer-Tomizuka, played a pivotal role in shaping our youth programs. We also welcomed Jade Childress as our Youth Initiatives Manager, a new position made possible through a partnership with AmeriCorps Tech Connection. Their leadership has been instrumental in expanding We Care Tucson's reach and impact.

In addition to youth programming, our digital literacy efforts continued to thrive. Partnering with UnitedHealthcare Medicare Store, we provided free basic computer classes at their Crossroads Festival location and at the We Care Tucson store on the first and third Saturdays of each month. These workshops were designed to make Windows 10 more accessible, empowering seniors with the confidence to navigate technology in an increasingly digital world.

Meanwhile, the demand for our free medical supplies and durable medical equipment loan chest has reached unprecedented levels. Thanks to strong partnerships with local homecare agencies and community organizations, we've been able to hold successful medical drives. However, as quickly as our shelves are stocked, they are emptied again—especially our incontinence supplies, underscoring the urgent need for these essential resources in Southern Arizona.

We closed out the year with the 2nd Annual Pickle-icious Jingle Jam Pickleball Fundraiser, an event that perfectly captured the spirit of community and generosity that defines We Care Tucson. Once again, it was an overwhelming success, bringing people together in support of our mission.

Ending 2024 on a high note, we undertook a major store reorganization to enhance efficiency and better serve our community. We invite you to stop by and see the remarkable improvements that further our mission of removing barriers to information, education, and wellness.




